

#### THE FOOD

On your first morning, Huseyin's family serve you a welcome breakfast (creamy feta, omelettes, sweet cucumbers and juicy peaches), and it just gets better from there. Need shopping? Just Whats App a list to Zubeyde and the local mini market delivers within the hour (no extra charge). With the lira weak against the pound, it's cheap to eat out - try Fish Terrace for panoramic views and giant prawns, or Korsan Meze for an Ottolenghi-worthy spread (korsankalkan.com)

## THE LOCATION

Beautiful Kalkan is a 10-minute taxi ride away for shisha cafes, boutiques and clubs. If you like your beaches wild and untouristy, drive 20 minutes west to Patara, one of Turkey's best beaches, where the waves pound like the Atlantic. Saklikent National Park, famous for its waterfalls, is 40 minutes north, while further on is Pinara, with its ancient ruins. For shopping, Kas is like a bigger Kalkan, with cool boutiques.

#### THE LOOK

At the end of a rocky track that winds along the coast from the seaside town of Kalkan on Turkey's south coast lies Korsan Guney: an imposing three-storey mansion overlooking the Mediterranean Sea. Inside is all white, with glass doors opening out to the pool, plus five bedrooms. A path leads to a private jetty over the rocks, where you'll find sun loungers and a kayak, and can dive straight into the sea. And, when you've had too much sun, cool off with a game of pool in the shade.
